

Thank you for becoming a member of the Nevada Union Junior Miners!

Here is what happens now...

1. **The \$185 participation fee is due by June 1, 2010 (if you have not paid in full).** Payments received after this date will be assessed a \$100.00 late fee. If you have not paid, your child will not participate. There are no payment plans available. No exceptions! So, please start planning now.
 - a. If you wish to pay the participation fee through **Program Ad Sales / Sponsorships**), use the attached form. If you know you will need additional forms, please make copies of the one that is attached before having a sponsor fill it out. The ads must be received by June 1, 2010.
 - b. Program Ad Sales / Sponsorships are not refundable, even if your child is cut from the team or decides not to participate.
 - c. **To remit payment, mail your checks to NUJM, P.O. Box 2017, Grass Valley, CA 95945, BEFORE June 1, 2010 to avoid a late fee.**
2. **Your child must have a Sports Physical completed AFTER April 15th but BEFORE the first day of practice, July 19th, or they will not be allowed to participate for insurance reasons.** The attached Medical Clearance Form should be completed and stamped by the physician. NUJM will hold a Sports Physical Clinic before the start of the season. See attached flyer for details.
3. There will be **OPTIONAL football camps** before practice begins, May 21-22. This camp requires a nominal fee, and is a lot of fun. Pre-registration for this camp is not necessary. Just show up at the NU stadium on Friday, May 21st at 6pm with the \$30 registration fee.
4. There will be no mandatory orientation meeting this year. Football equipment will be distributed on **Saturday, July 10, 2010** at the Litton Hill Equipment Trailer according to the following schedule:

13-14 year olds	10 a.m.
10-12 year olds	11 a.m.
6-9 year olds	12 a.m.

There will also be a **\$50.00 refundable equipment deposit** per child when equipment is distributed.

Cheer uniforms will be distributed after the first two weeks of practice at the practice field. Directions to the Litton Trailer are as follows:

Take Sierra College Blvd. To the roundabout

Turn onto Litton Drive

Follow Litton Drive up the hill to the softball field gate on the RIGHT

Go through the gate and the trailer will be on the immediate RIGHT

5. **Practice begins Monday, July 19, 2010.** The first two weeks of practice are try-outs. If you wish to make the team, DO NOT miss the first two weeks of practice!
