PLEASE take the time to read this letter!

We are very excited that you have decided to become a member of the Nevada Union Junior Miners Youth Football and Cheer program. Before you begin your journey with us, there are a few things you NEED to know.

1. **Membership Fees are non-refundable.** If your child decides not to participate or is cut from the team, the \$100 from this fee remains the property of the Nevada Union Junior Miners. This money is used to help offset the cost of administration fees (such as membership letters, registration forms, copies and stamps), as well as costs that we incur in preparation for your child to participate in our program (i.e. equipment that must be ordered ahead of time).
2. **The participation fee of \$185 is due by June 1, 2010.** This fee helps cover the cost of all of the equipment and uniforms that are purchased and replaced every couple of years, field usage fees for practice and games, referees, insurance, training and certification programs and seminars for our coaches, medical equipment, administration costs (such as copies, binders for player books, etc.) annual helmet reconditioning and more. This fee is refundable if your child decides not to participate or is cut within the first two weeks of practice. However, if part or all of the funds for this fee were paid for through the sale of Program Ads, that portion of the fee is NOT refundable.
3. **This program relies on parent support and involvement.** Parents of children in this program are required to work two hours PER home game for the first child participating in the program, and an additional two hours per season for each additional child. We do our best to make our parent volunteers feel valued and appreciated and to keep their jobs as fun as possible, but without the help, we cannot function. Parents that do not complete the required volunteer time will pay \$50 for each hour that is not served.
4. **The first two weeks of practice are try-outs and require your child to participate every day. Players and cheerleaders WILL be cut from teams.** Our league limits each of our teams/squads to a certain number of player/cheerleaders. This allows all of the player/cheerleaders a fair amount of playing time. Unfortunately, this also means that some player/cheerleaders that try out may have to be cut. The coaches do their best to recognize determination and perseverance. A child's bad attitude will almost guarantee that he/she will be cut from the team. We also maintain a strict discipline policy, and players and cheerleaders are required to maintain good character on and off the field.

- ____ (Parent Initials) I/We have read, understand and agree, as parent/guardian of the below named child to abide by the role of the parent and player's code of conduct and assume the absolute financial obligation for my/our child to participate in this youth program.
- The child named below has read, understands and agrees to abide by the player code of conduct.
- ____ (Parent Initials) The parent/guardian of the below named child, do hereby give my/our approval for participation in **Local Association (LA)/Sierra Youth Football & Cheer (SYFC)** activities for the current season. I/We assume all risks and hazards to this participation for any claims arising out of injury to the above named child, including, but not limited to, transportation to and from such activities. I/We hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless, **LA/SYFC**, the league, local team, organizers, managers, coaches, supervisors, participants, person providing transportation and any organization this youth football program may be affiliated with.

I/We acknowledge that I/We understand that our personal medical/dental insurance will remain the primary carrier, and that insurance offered through this program is secondary in nature and is subject to an annual deductible by the carrier. It is understood that any claim for injury arising out of my/our child's participation must be reported to the designated association official within 30 days of the date of injury. It is also understood that the proof of loss must be completed in full and filed within 60 days of receipt by **LA/SYFC**. All monies I/We have paid to the team do not constitute payment of insurance coverage. I/We do indemnify **LA/SYFC**, the association and the insurance carrier should there be statement(s) by anyone that is in contradiction. I/We attest I/We has read and understand the terms of this contract and any disclosure information required.
- ____ (Parent Initials) I/WE understand that if player/cheerleader has not had their physical examination they will not be allowed to participate in any **LA/SYFC** activities. I/We hereby grant authority to a qualified physician to administer such medical treatment, as said physician deems necessary under emergency circumstances.
- LA/SYFC players and cheerleaders can participate in other organized sports as long as it does not interfere with any of the LA /SYFC practices and games. Attendance is necessary to continue involvement. School sports are encouraged along with any type of program that would help your child excel in the sport of Football and Cheerleading.**

RELEASE OF LIABILITY FOR MINOR PARTICIPANTS
READ BEFORE SIGNING

IN CONSIDERATION OF _____ my child/ward, being allowed to participate in any way with the **Nevada Union Jr. Miners**, that is a member of the 2010 season with the Sierra Youth Football and Cheer league related events and activities, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates, and agrees that:

1. The risk of injury to my child/ward from the activities involved in these programs is significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while particular rules, equipment, and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist; and,

2. I FOR MYSELF, SPOUSE, AND CHILD/WARD, I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and assume full responsibility for my child/ward's participation; and,

3. I willingly agree to comply with the program's stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. If I observe any unusual significant concern in my child/ward's readiness for participation and/or in the program itself, I will remove my child/ward from the participation and bring such attention of the nearest official immediately; and,

4. 2010 SYFC PARENT CODE OF ETHICS

I hereby pledge to provide support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in youth sports by following this Parent's Code of Ethics:

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, cheerleaders, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other youth sports events.

I will place the emotional and physical well being of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.

I will require that my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the Coaches' Code of Ethics.
